#### 1. Introduction

Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation is having 4 major hospitals & medical colleges, 16 peripheral hospitals, 5 speciallized hospitals, 30 maternity homes & 192 dispensaries, HBT 242 HBT Clinics. Average daily 50,000 out patients outdoor & 2000 in patients put together in all BMC facilities. Presently Life style disorder & non communicable disease like cancers disease is major concern to health facilities.

In Mumbai, Tata Cancer Hospital & few Private Hospitals presently are providing Advance Oncology services to patients which are insufficient & not affordable to poor & needy persons. Hence BMC has decided to tie up with private partner to participate in developing such dedicated advance oncology care facilities for poor & needy at affordable rate as well as viable to them to run it for long period with their clinical, technical expertise which will bring efficient utilization of present structure.

To prepare draft, learns from their experiences & take inputs from them, understand criticality, various financial models to build & operate such facility, it is incumbent on BMC to invite such expert organization on one platform & shared input of all will help to finalize RFP documents which stand to scrutiny of transparency accountability, purity & efficiency, at the same time viability of project. Hence EOI are invited for such expert agency to submit their opinion to finalize RFP.

#### 2. Expression of Interest

This Expression of Interest intends to communicate, receive desired information and concretize on types and extent of Proton Therapy Treatment facilities to be covered, various models of engagement of possible private partner, roles and responsibilities of different stakeholders, standards of service level delivery and benchmarking etc, and thereafter, short listing of interested private partners/applicants for aforementioned purposes. Subsequently, a RFP will be issued on the basis of above, suitable Public-Private Partnership vendors/partners to established, finance, construct, operate & maintain Proton Therapy Treatment facilities on PPP basis & to operationalize the scheme.

This EOI is for deciding/finalizing scope and extent of diagnostic services, partnership model and for short listing of private agencies/partners which will help BMC in

organizing and starting Proton Therapy Treatment facility/centre at site of Acworth Hospital of Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation or most feasible site in Mumbai.

Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation may shortlist/select one or many partners for the next stage of RFP. Further, the final selection would be of Public-Private Partnership separately. It will be the complete discretion of BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION to decide on this issue.

Private Agencies of good standing and repute having skills, capacities and experience in the providing similar services are invited to submit their proposals to BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.

# 3. Proton Therapy Treatment Facilities/Services

- 3.1 BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION through KEM Hospital is plans to establish a state of arts wide network of Proton Therapy Treatment facilities/centers, primarily on PPP model. The entire project is proposed to be structured in a hierarchical fashion with three tiers of centers.
- 3.2 At the highest level, a oncology centre will be developed at Acworth Hospital, Mumbai with private participation. This will be the state of art centre with latest equipment and treatment facilities at par with best centre in India.
- 3.3 BMC is under process of construction of most advance proton therapy oncology centre wherein most of the advanced diagnostics and treatment facilities for cancer would be offered. The list of BMC Hospital & medical colleges where proposed for oncology facilities are as follows:
  - K.E.M. Hospital
  - B.Y.L. Nair Hospital & Medical college
  - L.T.M.G. Hospital & Medical college
  - H.B.T. Cooper & Medical college
  - B.D.B.A. Shatabdi Hospital, Kandivali
  - Rajawadi Hospital, Ghatkopar
- 3.4 At the lowest level, facilities would be developed to have tissue collection and primary detection facilities. Doctors and other staff would suitably be trained and required infrastructure will be made available for this purpose in peripheral hospitals.

#### 4. Objective and Scope of Work/Services

- 4.1. The centers are proposed to be developed with the participation of private sector partners.
- 4.2 The exact type and scope of involvement and responsibilities would be decided before issue of detailed RFP. However, a proposed model of involvement is discussed in following paragraphs.
- 4.3 In brief, the proposed model envisages government involvement in providing space, where as the private partner would be responsible for providing necessary design, finance, construction & infrastructure, equipment, consumables, technical and other manpower and for running and maintaining the facilities. The supervision and monitoring would be in the hands of government, which will be exercised through designated authority/agency/committee at KEM Hospital.
- 4.4 The private partner will be responsible for the entire operation and management of the centre under government supervision; will undertake diagnostics and treatment of the patients of BMC hospital. The services may also be extended to patients referred from other government/private hospitals under specific terms and condition to be decided.
- 4.5 It is proposed that all OPD patients would be treated at pre decided charges. Further, there would be charges for in-patients availing different facilities/treatment at the centers.
- 4.6 The types of facilities, infrastructure and services to be offered at different centers have also been proposed tentatively.
- 4.7 The Financial model would thus be based on a combined evaluation of rates which were to be charged by private partner for different treatment/services. For determining the final rates, corresponding rates of various treatments available in CGHS/AIIMS may be taken as base, and bidders may be asked to offer a discount on these rates. However, other reasonable criteria may also be adopted to finalize the financial bids of the proposal at RFP stage.

#### 4.8 Proposed Model in PPP Mode

- The Advance Proton Therapy treatment Center / Oncology centre is expected to run on a PPP mode.
- BMC will provide like suitable land for necessary infrastructure creation.
- All equipment and support infrastructure shall be provided by the private partner. The equipment installed would have to be brand new and USFDA compliant.
- Doctors for running the cancer diagnostic and treatment facilities should be provided by the private partner. Rest of the manpower (Para medicals, Nurses, Technicians, Administrative and Support Staff etc) will also be provided by the

- private party.
- Day to day operational cost such as medicine cost, consumables/reagents costs etc. for the centers shall be borne by the private party.
- 4.9 Proposed Roles and Responsibilities of Different Parties

#### **Private Sector**

- To design, finance, build, equip the necessary infrastructure for proton therapy treatment center,
- To provide all equipment and manpower,
- Develop (Functional Modifications) and operate the Treatment & Diagnostic center as per various national and international standards,
- Recruit/Staff human resource for diagnostic center,
- Ensure robust Management Information System (MIS) to provide critical information to BMC,
- Maintenance and up gradation of the machines,
- Maintain quality & inventory of the consumables,
- Adhere to its all contractual obligations,
- Other necessary scope of work will be finalized in RFP.

#### **Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation**

- To provide covered space for construction of building require to established & operate Advance Proton Therapy Treatment Center / Oncology centre of KEM Hospital at Acworth.
- To provide adequate space for Proton Therapy treatment Center and ensure smooth handover of the designated space to the private operator
- To provide doctors for administrative supervision and monitoring.
- Monitor KPI's defined in the concession
- Facilitate patient flow to the Centers from BMC Hospitals
- Provide assistance to the private operator in obtaining the requisite approvals/clearances
- Provide private patients access to the operator
- Facilitate referral of public patients to centre by making the Proton Therapy treatment
   Center as a referral centre for the BMC.
- Proton Therapy treatment Center / Oncology centre of KEM Hospital at Acworth, or any other suitable location, propose to be offered

- Proton Therapy treatment
- LINAC MACHINES
- Diagnostic
- Wards
- Other necessary arrangement as per final decision & requirement of PPP Partner.

#### 6. Eligibility Criteria / Qualifications / Instructions

- 6.1 The Agency / private hospital/ private diagnostic center etc. should have been in existence for last 5 years from the last date of submission of bid either alone or in consortium.
- 6.2 The Bidder should have provided similar kind of services for at least last three consecutive years, similar services means Hospital's oncology services, standalone oncology center, Diagnostic center etc.
- 6.3 The Bidder should have annual average turnover of Rs. 50 (Fifty) Cr. from similar services during the last three financial years (2021-22 to 2023-24) as per the audited financial statements of the agency duly certified by the statutory auditor.
- 6.4 The Bidder should not have been blacklisted by any state or central government department or agency. An affidavit to this effect need to be submitted with the bids.
- 6.5 The Bidder should preferably not be under litigation with any state or central government department or agency in any court of law. An affidavit making disclosure of such litigation or free from litigation status must be enclosed with the bids.
- 6.6 The Bidder, to qualify for short listing, shall submit a power of attorney authorizing the signatories of the bid to commit each member of the Partnership/Consortium/Joint venture, if applicable.
- 6.7 Memorandum of Understanding shall have to be provided in case the Bidder comprises of Joint venture/Consortium/Partnership.
- 6.8 Nomination of one of the members of the partnership, consortium or joint venture to be in charge and this authorization shall be covered in the power of attorney signed by the legally authorized signatories of all members of consortium/joint venture/partnership firm;
- 6.9 Details of the intended participation by each member shall be furnished with complete details of the proposed division of responsibilities and corporate relationships among the individual members.
- 6.10 The bidder shall submit full details of his ownership and control or, if the Bidder is a partnership, joint venture or consortium, full details of ownership and control of each member thereof.
- 6.11 Bidder or members of a partnership, joint venture or consortium shall submit a copy of PAN card No. under Income Tax Act.

- 6.12 Bidder must submit copies of all documents required, duly self-attested, along with technical bid of the EOI.
- 6.13 Each Bidder (each member in the case of partnership firm/joint venture/consortium) or any associate is required to confirm and declare with his bid that no agent, middleman or any intermediary has been, or will be, engaged to provide any services, or any other item or work related to the award and performance of this EOI. They will have to further confirm and declare that no agency commission or any payment which may be construed as an agency commission will be paid and that the EOI price will not include any such amount. If BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION subsequently finds to contrary, then it reserves the right to declare the Bidder as non-compliant and declare any contract if already awarded to the Bidder to be null and void.
- 6.14 Canvassing or offer of an advantage or any other inducement by any person with a view to influencing acceptance of a bid will be an offence under Laws of India. Such action will result in the rejection of bid, in addition to other punitive measures.

#### 7. One Bid per Bidder

Each bidder shall submit only one EOI either by himself or as a partner in joint venture or as a member of consortium. If a bidder or if any of the partners in a joint venture or any one of the members of the consortium participate in more than one bid, the bids are liable to be rejected.

#### 8. Cost of Bidding and Fees

- The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his bid and the Department will in no case shall be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the EOI process.

### 9. EOI Document

#### 9.1 Contents of EOI Document

The Expression of Interest Document has been prepared for the purpose of inviting interest bidders for short listing of agencies. This document comprises of following:

A. Notice inviting Expression of Interest.

- B. Detailed Document of EOI comprising the terms and conditions
- C. Technical Forms to be filled and submitted by the applicants/bidders (Annexure I)
- 9.2 The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, Forms, Terms and Conditions in this EOI document. Failure to furnish all information required by the EOI document or submission of EOI not substantially responsive to the EOI document in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of his bid.
- 9.3 The bidder shall not make or cause to be made any alteration, erasure or obliteration to the text of the EOI document.

#### 10. Clarification on EOI Document

- 10.1 In case the bidder has any doubt about the meaning of anything contained in the EOI document, he shall seek clarification from the Office of BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION not later than one week before submitting his bid. Any such clarification, together with all details on which clarification had been sought, will be copied to all bidders. All communications between the bidder and BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION shall be carried out in writing/email.
- 10.2 Except for any such written clarification by the BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, which is expressly stated to be an addendum to the EOI document issued by BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, no written or oral communication, presentation or explanation by any other employee of BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION shall be taken to bind or fetter BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION under the contract.

# 11. Preparation of Bids

#### 11.1 Language:

The bids and all accompanying document shall be in English. In case any accompanying documents are in other languages, it shall be accompanied by an English translation. The English version shall prevail in matters of interpretation.

#### 11.2 Documents comprising the Bid:

- EOI document issued for the purposes of EOI and any amendments issued shall be deemed as incorporated in the Bid.
- 11.3 The bidder shall, on or before the date given in the Notice Inviting EOI, submit his bid. The bidder shall submit the technical bid in sealed envelopes clearly marked with the name of the EOI.

- 11.4 One copy of the EOI document and Addenda, if any, thereto with each page signed and stamped shall be attached to acknowledge the acceptance of the same.
- 11.5 These shall be addressed to the Dean, KEM Hospital, Parel Mumbai-4.00012 and submitted in the Office address given in the EOI document.
- 11.6 The Bidder shall also be required to submit a written concept plan, working methodology, types and extent of Proton therapy treatment center and advance oncology diagnostic services to be covered, proposed model of participation, roles and responsibilities of different stakeholders, standards of service level delivery and benchmarking etc. for managing such centers at Acworth of KEM Hospital. This plan should also contain an executive summary along with flow chart and diagrams so as to communicate properly the whole concept and plan. BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION also requires that the applicants present the same in front of evaluation team constituted for this purpose.

#### 12. Form of Bid

The Form of Bid shall be completed in all respects and duly signed and stamped by an authorized and empowered representatives of the Bidder. If the Bidder comprises a partnership firm, consortium or a joint venture, the Form of Bid shall be signed by a duly authorized representative of each member of participant thereof. Signatures on the Form of Bid shall be witnessed and dated. Copies of relevant power of attorney shall be attached.

#### 13. Period of EOI – Validity

13.1 The contract is proposed to be initially for one year, which may further be extended for one more years on mutual agreement of both parties. However, BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION reserves the right to curtail or to extend the validity of contract on the same rates and terms and conditions for such period as may be agreed to.

#### 14. Format and Signing of Bid

- 14.1 The bidder shall submit one copy of the EOI document and addenda, if any, thereto, with each page of this document signed and stamped to confirm the acceptance of the terms and conditions of the EOI by the bidder.
- 14.2 The documents comprising the  $\begin{array}{c} \text{bid shall} \\ \text{11} \end{array}$  be typed or written in indelible ink and all

- pages of the bid shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the bidder. All pages of the bid, where entries or amendments have been made, shall be signed by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 14.3 The bid shall contain no alterations, omissions or additions except those to comply with instruction issued by the Corporation, or are necessary to correct errors made by the bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed /signed and dated by the person or persons signing the bid.

#### 15. Submission of Bid

- 15.1 The bidder shall submit the Bid in a sealed cover duly super scribed with "Bids for Public-Private Partnership for Proton therapy treatment center and advance oncology Treatment Facilities at KEM Hospitals in Mumbai".
- 15.2 The sealed cover of Pre-qualification Bid and Technical Bid should consist of the Following documents, in addition to other documents/forms:-
  - (a) Details of the firm/agency with name, official's details, Office/Residential address and office Telephone numbers, whether the bidder is a sole proprietor/partnership firm and if partnership firm, names addresses and telephone numbers of Directors/Partners also;
  - (b) Self attested copy of PAN No. card under Income Tax Act;
  - (c) Self attested copy of GST Registration Certificate;
  - (d) Self attested copy of Valid Registration No. of the agency/Firm;
  - (e) Self attested copy of valid Provident Fund Registration Number;
  - (f) Self attested copy of valid ESI Registration Number;
  - (g) Self attested copy of valid License and Number under Contract Labour Act and under any other Acts/Rules;
  - (h) Proof of Average Annual turnover supported by audited Balance Sheet;
  - (i) Duly filled and signed Annexure I

#### 16. Late and Delayed EOI

16.1 Bids must be received in BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION at the address

- specified above not later than the date and time stipulated in the EOI Document. BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids in which case all rights and obligations of BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION and the Bidder will remain the same.
- 16.2 Any bid received by BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION after the timeline for submission of bids, as stipulated above, shall not be considered and will be returned unopened to the bidder.

#### 17. Bid Opening and Evaluation

- 17.1 The authorized representatives of BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION will open the Bids in the presence of the Bidders or of their representatives who choose to attend at the appointed place and time.
- 17.2 The bid of any bidder who has not complied with one or more of the conditions will be summarily rejected.
- 17.3 Subsequently, the technical bids will be evaluated by the evaluation team as per the terms and conditions of this document.
- 17.3 Right to accept any bid and to reject any or all bids
- 17.4 BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION is not bound to accept any or all bid and may at any time by notice in writing to the bidders terminate the EOI process.
- 17.5 BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION may terminate the contract if it is found that the agency is black listed on previous occasions by the any of the Departments/Institutions/Local Bodies/Municipalities/Public Sector Undertakings, etc.

#### 18. EOI Processes and Program/Scheme Briefing Meetings

- 18.1 BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION will hold at least one Program Briefing Meeting with prospective bidders/private partners before the closing of the EOI, on the date as specified in the timeline at the beginning of this document. Depending on the requirement and for concretizing the scheme, scope of work and terms of engagements, there could be more such Program Briefing Meetings, date and time of which would be notified only on the Website of BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.
- 18.2 After short listing of bidders/private partners, BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION will again hold at least one Program Briefing Meeting before issuing RFP document. Again, there could be more than one such Program Briefing Meetings, the date and time of which would be intimated to successful shortlisted bidders through email/phone and through website.
